CFE Fund Approach: Helping government leaders embed financial empowerment strategies into municipal infrastructure




- Design and fund innovative, multi-city programs


FEC Impact to Date

Planning Grant Overview

- Cohort of <u>up</u> to 15 local governments working towards launching a FEC
- \$20,000 planning grant
- CFE Fund technical assistance, 9-month grant term, with focus on:
 - Program Design
 - Partnership Development
 - Fundraising and Sustainability



Planning Phase Deliverables

- Attend in-person training/kick off on October 16-17, NYC
- Plan and support a CFE Fund site visit
- Identify stakeholders and logistics for Advisory Group
- Draft and submit the Implementation Proposal
 - $_{\odot}$ Secure the financial counseling provider
 - $_{\odot}$ Outline the training plan for the financial counselors and managers
 - $_{\odot}$ Plan for or hire a dedicated local government manager
 - Identify or secure a minimum of 8 partnerships
 - \circ Secure match funding




Implementation Phase

- Planning Grantees who have met all Planning Phase
 Deliverables and submit a successful Implementation Proposal are eligible to move to the Implementation Phase.
- CFE Fund support will include:
 - 1:1 match of \$150,000 in the first year, and a 1:2 match of \$100,000 in the second year.
 - Intensive implementation technical assistance, trainings, and resources for two years.




Planning Grant Timeline



DESIGN Up to 9 Months







"BUILD" the FEC Up to 3 Months IMPLEMENTATION for 24 Months

\$20,000 Planning Grant

Matching Funds Year One: minimum of \$150,000 Year Two: minimum of \$200,000



Planning Phase Roles

Local Government

- Designate 1-2 staff members to serve as CFE Fund liaisons
- Lead all planning and design efforts
- Work with local stakeholders
- Participate in planning calls and in-person meetings
- Attend learning community events
- Support fundraising efforts



CFE Fund Planning Grant Technical Assistance

- Lead regular calls and be available via email
- Conduct at least one site visit
- Host learning community activities
- Guidance on fundraising activities
- Provide access to a range of documents and templates
- \$20,000 planning grant



Eligibility

- Local governments (cities or counties) with more than 75,000 residents
- Must demonstrate commitment from Mayor, County Leader, City Manager or other key senior leadership to launch a FEC
 - Must provide letter of support from government leadership, and two reference letters from community partners

*Note: Only Planning grantees are eligible to apply for the Implementation grant



Important Dates

- Planning Grant due date: August 9, 2019
- Notification of selection:
 September 2019
- Mandatory Kick-Off Training in NYC: October 16-17, 2019
